- Any players who attend school at Lial shall play for the parish closest to where they reside. Any student who attends St. John's Junior Academy or St. Francis de Sales may choose to play at either the school or at their home parish.
- Those wishing to play who are members of a non-territorial parish (St. Patrick Historic, Corpus Christi, St. Joseph – Downtown,...) shall play at the parish closest to where they reside.

- Any player from a parish, which is not listed above, must contact the CYO office before they are allowed to practice for any CYO team.
- Any player who played football for a sponsoring parish last season will have the opportunity to play for that same team again this season, but must submit a “Transfer Application” to the CYO office **before they begin practicing.**
- If any of the above sponsoring parishes does not have enough players to field a team or a parish listed as an additional parish has enough players to field their own team the CYO staff will make necessary adjustments to the above list.
- Playing time and/or conflicts with a coach will not be means for the above list being changed or adjusted. The same is true for transportation issues.
