- CYO Staff (Assistant Director Jack Jordan and Administrative Assistant Kathy Rakay)
- No fee increases \$45/player; team fee remains at \$150
- Coaches' eligibility
 - Change in procedure to register for certification classes
 - o Diocesan policy on screening volunteers who work with youth
 - www.VIRTUSonline.org
 - o Concussion awareness (coaches/parents) House Bill 143 (since April 2013)
 - Coaches: view video, submit Certification to CYO Office every 3 years;
 - Parent/Athlete: be presented required information sheet, both parent and athlete must sign and date
 - Sudden Cardiac Arrest Ohio Senate Bill 152 "Lindsay's Law" (since July 2017)
 - Coaches: view required video, be presented required coaches' information sheet, submit Certificate of Completion to CYO Office;
 - Parent/Athlete: view required video, be presented required parent/athlete information sheet, sign & return to parish
 - Review of "Standards of Behavior" form
- Behavior of coaches & parents
- Player eligibility
- Safety regulations
 - o Forms submitted (updated ODH Concussion Awareness form/SCA form)
 - o Physical each year (updated Player/Parent contract form/EMA form)
 - o Emergency contingency plan among coaches
- Schedule requests, Officials, Game report forms
- CYO website / Facebook page (like us at CYO Toledo)
- CYO Complex
 - Use for practices and/or scrimmages
 - 20th anniversary (played at Complex Fall of 1999)

CYO Points of Emphasis

Forms/physicals – no athletes may practice without every form completed and on file

- Conditioning for at least the first four days at the CYO Complex to facilitate combinations 6:00pm at CYO fields – all meet together for a welcome & prayer, then teams will go to their assigned fields to condition. Coaches are asked to check in with CYO Staff to report the number of athletes at the end of practice.
