Documents and Papers Requiring Signature(s) of Petitioner and Advocate

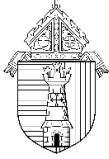
- Appointment of Procurator/Advocate Form**
- Libellus** (Formal Petition)
- Application** (including *Facts Sheets, Witness Form, Statement of Understanding, and Donation Form*)
- Advocate’s Initial Brief** – *cover letter; only needs Advocate’s signature*

Required Civil and Ecclesiastical (Church) Documents

- A recent (last 6 months) baptismal certificate** with all notations or proof of Profession of Faith for the Petitioner and/or Respondent if she/he was Catholic or joined the Catholic Church. *When applying for this document from your parish of baptism, please be sure to ask for “notations” to be included;*
- Civil Application for Marriage License** (ask specifically for this exact form from the county where you obtained your marriage license) with attached **Certificate of Marriage**;
- Catholic Marriage Certificate** for anyone married in the Catholic Church
- Civil Divorce/Dissolution Decree** (which must include the official stamp showing the filing date);
- Complete Separation Agreement**;
- Legal change of name** if not documented in the civil termination papers.

If your marriage took place in your parish, please request a COPY of the Prenuptial File from the pastor or parish secretary for inclusion with other required documents.

No petition will be accepted until all required signatures and/or documents and forms have been submitted to the Tribunal. Return this checklist with your application. Be sure to duplicate any document you may be submitting for any other former marriage.

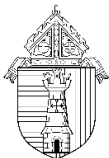

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**STATEMENT OF
UNDERSTANDING
MARRIAGE NULLITY:
ABBREVIATED PROCESS**

Please sign and date the statement below:

I believe that the above-mentioned marriage was invalid according to the law of the Catholic Church based on the facts and proofs that are proposed herein, and I request that the Bishop of the Diocese of Toledo judge whether this marriage is proven to be invalid according to the abbreviated process. I recognize that the materials gathered for this judicial process are open to the officials of the Tribunal and the Respondent and are available for review by the psychological and other experts used by the Tribunal.

I understand that if the requirements for the abbreviated process, including the manifest invalidity of my marriage and the consent of the Respondent to the use of the abbreviated process, are not met, my petition will be admitted to the ordinary process if it is otherwise admissible. I further understand that even if my cause is admitted to the abbreviated process, it is not a guarantee of an affirmative decision; if the Bishop is not morally certain of the nullity of my marriage, my cause will be remitted to the ordinary process.

I understand that during the instruction of my cause, the parties and all the witnesses must come to the Tribunal of the Diocese of Toledo on the same day and at the same time to give an oral deposition.

I understand that no guarantee can be made as to the outcome of the case, that no definite time frame for a completion date can be established, and that no date for a new marriage can be set by a parish priest or deacon unless an affirmative decision is issued and no appeal has been made by either party or the Defender of the Bond. I recognize that this process is a purely ecclesiastical one and has no effect whatsoever on United States federal or state civil law.

I understand that the burden of proof is on me to overturn the legal presumption that my marriage is valid (c. 1060).

I swear before God and my conscience that all of the above information provided in this Application is true to the best of my knowledge and memory.

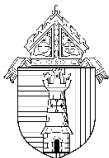

The Diocesan Tribunal is a pastoral ministry of the diocesan church and, like any other ministry, requires people who do the work and must be specially trained, offices where the work can be done, paperwork, utilities, and insurance.
