RE: Pre-Season Items

Please call the CYO office (419-244-6711, ext. 4932) today if there is a problem with the schedule (*i.e. we have a team scheduled that no longer exists or we have failed to schedule a team*).

All coaches must go to the CYO website to review all CYO Football Rules and Regulations prior to the start of the season.

All team rosters (signed by the parish pastor) and all team & player fees are due to the CYO office by Tuesday, September 4th. This is a FIRM deadline. Not all football teams submitted Team Entry Forms (and team fee) by the deadline of 8/17, so preparing the weigh-in and round robin schedules became a difficult task.

The Round Robin match-ups have been scheduled 60 minutes apart with 50 minutes (running clock) of playing time. The playing requirement (each player) is a minimum of 10 plays. Coaches must have their team inside the stadium at least 10 minutes before their scheduled starting time. All four teams will meet at mid-field prior to the start of each game for the CYO Prayer which will be read over the PA. We will shorten the playing time on the clock if teams do not cooperate in this matter. Please do your part so that we can keep all of the games on time and allow everyone the maximum time on the “turf”.

Any league schedule requests must be submitted in writing to the CYO office prior to the end of the Round Robin. Once the schedule has been established there will be no changes made.

As of this date we have received only a few transfer request forms. Coaches were asked not to assume that the transfers will be OK. If you have a boy playing on your team from a **NEIGHBORING** parish please forward his completed “Transfer Application” (with all required signatures) to the CYO office today.

ROUND ROBIN NOTES:

- The home team is listed first and will sit on the press box side of the field (closest to the school).
 - The visiting team (listed second) will begin on offense to start the game.
 - The visiting team will run 10 consecutive offensive plays and then the home team will get the ball for 10 consecutive offensive plays. This will continue until the fifty minutes (running clock per game) expires.
 - Please be organized. All players MUST play at least ten plays in this Round Robin.
 - There will be an admission charge of \$2 for adults and \$1 for students. PLEASE inform the parents about this charge!
 - All spectators will enter through the Northwest entrance.
 - Overflow parking will be available at the "neighboring" business lots across the street.
 - Spectators may sit on either side of the stadium, but must stay off the field and sidelines. PLEASE inform the parents.
 - The team warm up area will be on the east side of the stadium around the soccer field.
 - Pictures taken by **Domar Photography** will be taken in the front of the school. No other photographers should be present to take team pictures at the Round Robin. If you use a photographer other than Domar you are asked to have pictures taken at another time either at practice or a game. If you use Domar you are asked to have your team at St. John Jesuit High School at least 1 hour prior to your team's game.
 - Make this a great start to the season for everyone involved. Leave them all wanting more!
