THANK YOU for your cooperation at the Diocesan Meet! I think we were all concerned about the weather heading into (and sometimes during) the meet, but we were so pleased that the meet was able to be run to completion with the exception of a few minutes of rain. I don't think many of us would have believed at the beginning of the day that we'd get a complete meet in yesterday.

Thank you also for your dedication to the youth at your parish and the enthusiasm you share with them. 468 youth from 22 different parishes were registered to participate in this year's Championship meet. We felt that overall the meet was a success.

The individual results of each event from the 2017 CYO Diocesan Grade School Track Meet, along with the Team Standings, a Participation Report, and updated Diocesan Meet Records are now posted on the CYO website (www.toledodiocese.org/CYO). If you did not pick up your packet of awards at the conclusion of the meet that your participants may have earned throughout the day, these are now available at the CYO office. We had a glitch with the awards at the end of the meet yesterday. None of the 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, or 6th place medals/ribbons were recorded on the sheets attached to parish award envelopes, nor were they included in the envelopes. Some coaches stayed around at the end of the meet to receive all of their relay awards, but some did not. If you are missing medals and/or ribbons, please contact us ASAP and we will make arrangements to get to you what you are owed. We apologize!

Also, there are a few changes to team standings after proofing the results.

- In the Cadet Girls' division, Napoleon St. Augustine left the meet with a 3rd place trophy but they are actually tied for 2nd place with Bowling Green St. Aloysius; and
- In the Cadet Boys' division, Bowling Green St. Aloysius and Toledo St. Joan of Arc are actually tied with Assumption Holy Trinity for a share of 3rd place.

In case you missed it at the beginning of the meet, "Congratulations" go out to the family of Terry England, from Tiffin St. Joseph Parish who were presented with a plaque in memory of Terry, the recipient of the 2017 CYO Adult Contributor Award for Track, as well as the High School Student Athletes who were honored for both Track & Softball.
