

**Job Title: Director of Youth Faith Formation**

**Position Summary**

The Director of Youth Faith Formation develops missionary disciples who know, love and serve God as cheerful and committed members of the Catholic Church. The ministry leadership position oversees effective faith formation of middle and high school students, seeking expressly to facilitate an on-going encounter with Christ Jesus by advancing understanding and practice of the Catholic Faith of students and their parents.

**Primary Duties and Responsibilities**

- Creates, leads, promotes and evaluates the multi-year Confirmation preparation for students in Grades 6 – 8 (*Purpose*), working cooperatively with the Saint Benedict School middle school teachers and principal.
- Recruits, trains, mentors and evaluates core team members for *Purpose*.
- Creates, leads, promotes and evaluates the multi-year faith formation for students in Grades 9 – 12 (*Life Teen*).
- Recruits, trains, mentors core team members for *Life Teen*.
- Builds relationships with youth and their families aiming to deepen their parish engagement, seeking also to make meaningful connections outside of scheduled programs.
- Equips parents as the primary educators of their children.
- Serves as the leading pastoral presence at 5:30 p.m. Sunday *Life Teen* Mass, working cooperatively with the Director of Music and Pastor.
- Coordinates sacramental formation and reception for all children outside usual reception sequence (Baptism, Reconciliation, Eucharist and Confirmation).

**Other**

- Commits to continuous personal development including faith formation.
- Participates as a member of the parish Leadership Core Team.
- Attends continuing education seminars, workshops, etc. and participates in webinars as needed or directed by the Pastor.
- Participates weekly in Sunday 5:30 p.m. Mass and other weekend Masses as needed or requested by the Pastor.
